- Quality Assurance **tool for VET providers** from different national education and training systems and frameworks. The Criteria help to speak the same language of evaluation.
- **Transnational:** the members of the reviewer team are from the same and different country as the VET provider to be reviewed.
- Includes the educational institution operations as a whole: **14 Quality Areas**.
- **Customisable:** criteria can be used selectively or supplemented according to the context of the VET provider.
- Based on the **EQAVET+ Framework** and the principle of continuous improvement: planning, implementation, evaluation and review.

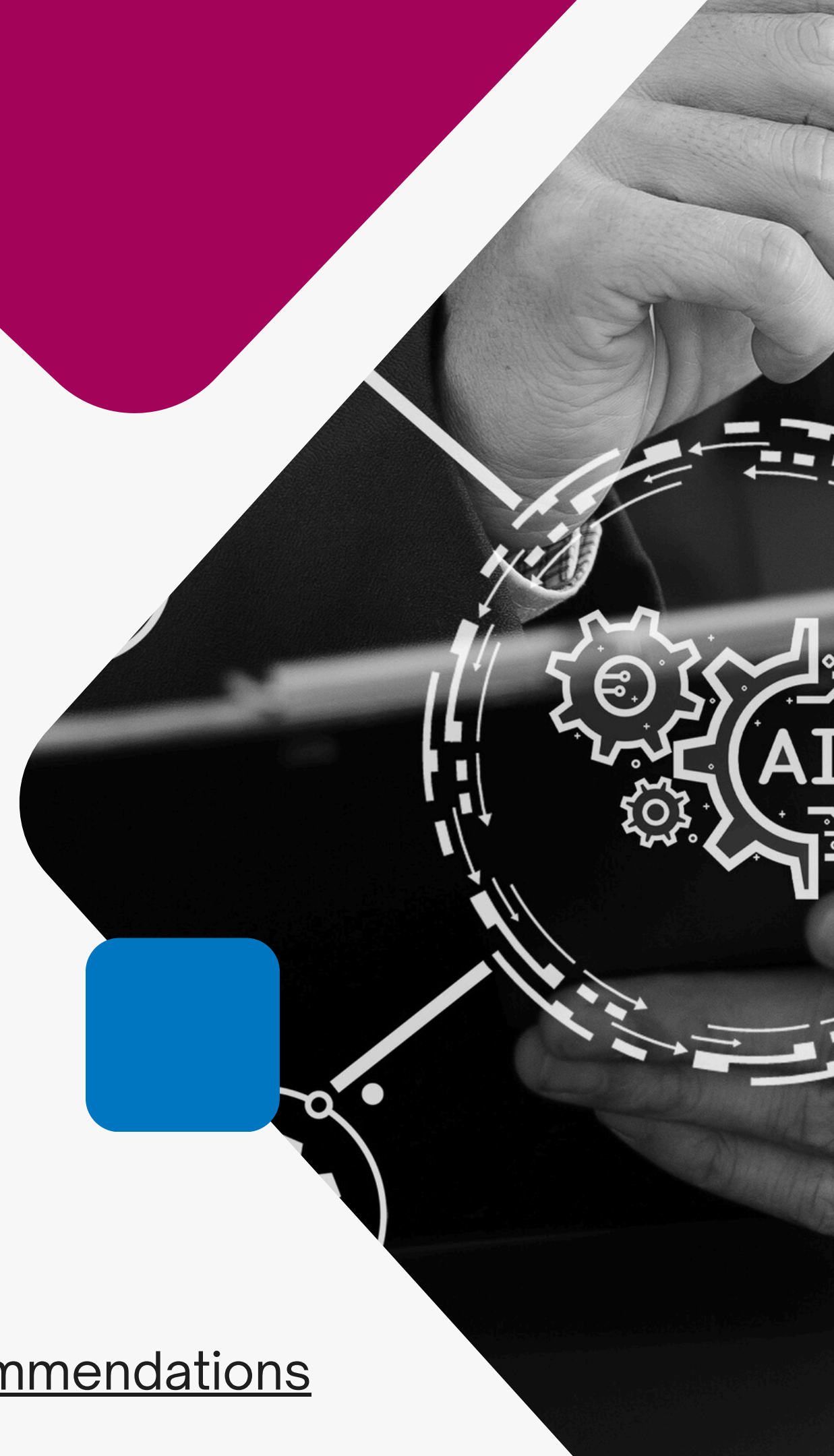

STRATEGIC ROLE OF PEER REVIEW WITHIN EQAVET

- **Embedding Quality Culture**
Peer Review fosters shared ownership of quality among leadership, teachers, learners and external stakeholders through dialogue and trust.
- **Driving Continuous Improvement**
Structured external feedback helps identify strengths and areas for improvement, focusing on learning and evidence-based decisions.
- **Strengthening Quality Assurance Systems**
Peer Review complements self-evaluation, reinforces quality cycles, and supports better strategic and operational decisions.
