**Learning outcomes of studies at  
 the level of higher education**

<p><b>In order to be awarded a Bachelor’s degree<sup>1</sup></b>, a student must be able to prove that he or she:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• knows the theoretical starting points and development directions of the field of study<sup>2</sup> and distinguishes facts from opinions;</li> <li>• is able to formulate problems relating to the field of study by planning data collection and analysing results;</li> <li>• is able to explain current topics of the field of study in a (foreign) language relevant to the field of study in different cultural environments, adapting his or her communication style to the target group;</li> <li>• is able to develop independently and in a team solutions to problems relating to the field of study, taking into account the opportunities and needs of team members and valuing innovation and entrepreneurship;</li> <li>• is able to perform professional tasks responsibly, creatively and ethically, coping with stressful situations and factors affecting physical and mental health;</li> <li>• is able to apply the acquired knowledge and skills safely, including through various digital and other technical means;</li> <li>• is able to establish learning objectives, analyse his or her learning process and consciously shape his or her learning and career path;</li> <li>• acts as a specialist and a citizen in ways that support the sustainability of the environment and society.</li> </ul>
<p><b>In order to be awarded a Master’s degree<sup>3</sup></b> a student must, in addition to the learning outcomes achieved in Bachelor’s or professional higher education studies, be able to prove that he or she:                  ...</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• is able to solve complex problems relating to the speciality as well as multidisciplinary problems with appropriate measures, including having limited information, and argue the impact of the solutions offered on the basis of evidence;</li> <li>• is able to apply the acquired knowledge and skills sustainably and strategically, demonstrating creativity, initiative, responsibility, team management skills, and knowledge of future directions and societal processes of the speciality;</li> <li>• is able to assess the development needs of himself or herself and others and support the learning of others by teaching, instructing and/or otherwise.</li> </ul>
<p><b>In order to be awarded a Doctoral degree<sup>4</sup></b>, a student must, in addition to the learning outcomes achieved in Master’s and Bachelor’s / professional higher education studies, be able to prove that he or she:                  ...</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• is able to solve complex problems relating to the field of research independently and in a team, including in international networks, based on good scientific practice;</li> <li>• is able to present/publish original research results or creative works to an international audience;</li> <li>• is able to develop methods of his or her research field, create connections between fields and generalise knowledge across fields;</li> <li>• is able to explain the social and environmental impact of research results on the public and make proposals based on them in sectoral and cross-sectoral networks and working groups;</li> <li>• is able to shape the next generation in the speciality by teaching, instructing and/or otherwise.</li> </ul>

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<sup>1</sup> The learning outcomes achieved on graduation from a Bachelor's study programme and from professional higher education studies are in conformity with the general requirements described at the 6th level of the qualifications framework.

<sup>2</sup> Field of study – depending on the specifics of the study programme, can also mean a speciality.

<sup>3</sup> The learning outcomes achieved on graduation from a Master's study programme (including upon completion of the integrated study programmes of Bachelor's and Master's studies) are in conformity with the general requirements described at the 7th level of the qualifications framework.
